



Nomansland Recreation Ground – what's going on?

Background:

Nomansland Sports Association (NSA) recently decided to dissolve the charity and this has raised concerns regarding the future of the facilities at Nomansland Recreation Ground. Some background:

- Landford Parish Council owns the land known as Nomansland Recreation Ground and leases it to the NSA. The Parish Council also owns and funds the children's play park.
- The NSA owns the clubhouse, tennis courts and skate park and Nomansland Community Events (NCE) manage the facilities on behalf of the NSA; these facilities are currently closed to the public. The dissolution of a charity in receipt of funding from grant providers is a complex process and the NSA is solely accountable for the negotiations and the outcome.

Update:

A third party has approached the NSA with a view to taking ownership of the assets and liabilities of the NSA. The proposal from the third party, which has been endorsed by Sports England (the primary grant provider), is being considered by the NSA. Landford Parish Council has been apprised of the situation and, as the landlord, is awaiting further information so that it may consider the implications for the Parish in any future lease.
