Issue Details

Location of Issue:	Road from Landford Crossroads to Nomansland Cattle Grid
Community Area:	Southern Wiltshire
Parish or Town Council:	Landford PC
Nature of Issue:	The road is not suitable for 40mph due to very narrow pavement and lots of usage from pedestrians (including the local school sites) and cyclists. There is also a blind corner at the cattle grid and I have witnessed several near misses over the years.
How long has it been an issue?	I have been aware of the issue for approximately 10 years but I expect it has been going on longer.
What would you like done to resolve this issue?	We would like to see this section reduced to 30mph. I have consulted with a prior Principal Engineer, Safer Routes for Hampshire Council as well as the local police force - both thought it was already a 30mph section and were amazed when I said it is still 40mph

Landford Parish Council does not support the assertion that the road is not suitable for 40 mph. Metro strips were installed in December 2023 and readings found insufficient evidence to support any change to the speed limit. Furthermore, rules governing a 30-mph limit are not met by the housing density on the road. The Council therefore does not agree there is an issue requiring resolution.
