### **Alderbury Rural Beat (Alderbury, Clarendon, Firsdown, Grimsteads, Landford, Laverstock/ Ford/ Old Sarum, Pitton & Farley, West Dean, Winterslow) - January 2019**

#### **Current local Policing Priorities**

- **Burglary (outbuildings, sheds, garages)**  
Targeted patrols and ongoing enqs – current hotspots Whiteparish/ Landford
- **Patrols to target Rural crime and Poaching**  
Patrols by Police officers and PCSOs to target both daytime and night poaching at identified hotspots (recent reports from West Dean/ Whiteparish area) Ongoing liaison and intelligence sharing with Hampshire Police to target cross border offending
- **Speed Enforcement checks to support local Community Speed Watch (CSW)**  
Our teams will carry out speed enforcement in areas identified via feedback from active CSW schemes – targeted areas are updated on a fortnightly basis – **current focus on Whiteparish A27**

#### **Crime summary (reports since mid December)**

30/12 (over 6 day period) – New Rd, Landford – forced entry to shed, search made nothing stolen  
29/12 (over 4 day period) – Martins Rise, W/Parish – gained entry to garage stole 2 bikes – Boardman pro and black BMX  
28/12 – Longhedge, Old Sarum – entered insecure vehicle and stole Ipad  
26/12 – Cowesfield, Whiteparish – entered and searched garage, nothing stolen  
24/12 (over 2 week period) – Common Rd, Whiteparish – forced entry to shed, stole yellow Suzuki RM65 motorcycle  
24/12 – Church Rd, Farley – entered and searched vehs on driveways, nothing stolen  
14/12 – Newton Close, Whiteparish – cut security bolt and stole Kawasaki m/cycle – later recovered in Hants police area
