No: 18/00392	HEMSBY COURT, LYNDHURST ROAD, LANDFORD, SALISBURY, SP5 2AP	Two storey extensions; replacement garage / carport; demolition of existing garage	<p>We recommend PERMISSION, for the reasons listed below, but would <u>accept the decision reached by the National Park Authority's Officers under their delegated powers</u></p> <p>The overall effect of the proposals do not have any detrimental effects on neighbours and the locality.</p> <p>If the officer is minded to approve the application the Parish Council requests that the following conditions are included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">permitted development rights for further extensions are removed - due to the floor space of the proposed extensions approaching the 30% limit,for the replacement windows, all vertical divisions should be fitted with casement frames and avoid direct glazing to frames - to comply with the recommendations of Landford Village design Statement, section 7.5 Windows, andthe horizontal subdivisions of each casement should form part of the window frame, and not just contained within the double glazed unit itself - to maintain the traditional appearance of windows.	13-06-18 DMW (Chairman), NJB, KPP, LAW, GLK
