21/01016 & 21/01017  (NFNPA)	Landford Lodge, Barrows Lane, Landford, Salisbury, SP5 2EH	Repair and refurbishment of listed stables building; external and internal alterations including conversion of first floor to Estate offices; replacement lean-to to rear of the stable building; coach house building consisting of garaging, equestrian and machine storage on the ground floor with flat above; 2no. dwellings; landscaped courtyard; restoration of staddle stone granary and adjacent machine store; cladding; demolition of existing lean-to structure to rear of stable building, 2no. stable buildings	The Parish Council unanimously recommend PERMISSION, for the reasons listed below, but would accept the decision reached by the National Park Authority's Officers under their delegated powers.  The appearance, location and purpose of the proposed buildings are acceptable, subject to a planning condition restricting the occupation of the new dwellings to workers on the Landford Lodge estate in perpetuity.

21/01076  (NFNPA)	Land Of Lyburn Farm, Adjacent To 4 Lyburn Road, Nomansland	Continued use of land for the stationing of 3no. mobile homes and 1no. welfare cabin between 15th November and 15th April in any year	The Parish Council unanimously recommend PERMISSION, for the reasons listed below, but would accept the decision reached by the National Park Authority's Officers under their delegated powers.  The applicants are a well-respected, local, agricultural business and the Parish Council have no objections to a temporary permission being granted for a further time period.
