Nature of Issue:

There's a general issue with the speed of vehicles using Hamptworth Road past the junction with Lyburn Road and the Cuckoo pub. Pedestrians, including children walking to catch school transport, dog walkers and large groups of ramblers, are forced to walk on the road as there are no verges and customers, who park on the south side of the road, have to cross to the pub. The problem is heightened by the bend in the road immediately to the west of the pub, vehicles turning out from Lyburn Road and vehicles manoeuvring to park outside the pub. There appears to be a steadily increasing volume of traffic using Hamptworth Road, Lyburn Road and Black Lane involving delivery vans, groups of cyclists, visitors to the pub and because of recent and future local business developments which makes the risk of a serious accident occurring much more likely.

What would you like done to resolve this issue?

Consideration should be given to imposing a reduced speed limit and better signage of the bend and the danger of pedestrians in the road.

There's a general issue with the speed of vehicles passing through the hamlet where several houses are very close to the road and where pedestrians, including children walking to catch school transport, dog walkers and large groups of ramblers, are forced to walk on the road as there are no verges. The danger is at its worst at the hidden bend close to Yew Tree Cottage where we have frequently witnessed near accidents. The problem has always existed but the risks are steadily increasing to critical levels because of a general increase in traffic, delivery vans etc and a recent dramatic increase in traffic including heavy vehicles accessing Black Lane due to numerous business developments.

Significant potholes and failing road edges resulting in dangerous driving conditions, vehicle damage, and associated damage to verges and hedgerows. Recent increased commercial activity in Hamptworth Estate's buildings on Black Lane have resulted in a significant increase in the size and frequency of commercial vehicles passing through the village.

2/ Speeding -

Many vehicles passing along Hamptworth Road travel in excess of 40mph. Crossing Hamptworth Rd to use the footpath to the North is often unsafe.

Many vehicles travelling along Lyburn Road pass the three properties at the Hamprtworth Road end at unsafe speeds. Although the speed limit is 40mph, The Highways Authority acknowledged that this stretch of road is more akin to a 30mph limit when submitting their comments in response to The Red House's planning application for a new road access and garage building.
