Location of Issue:	Hamptworth Road, Hamptworth
Community Area:	Salisbury
Parish or Town Council:	Landford
Nature of Issue:	<p>There's a general issue with the speed of vehicles using Hamptworth Road past the junction with Lyburn Road and the Cuckoo pub. Pedestrians, including children walking to catch school transport, dog walkers and large groups of ramblers, are forced to walk on the road as there are no verges and customers, who park on the south side of the road, have to cross to the pub. The problem is heightened by the bend in the road immediately to the west of the pub, vehicles turning out from Lyburn Road and vehicles manoeuvring to park outside the pub. There appears to be a steadily increasing volume of traffic using Hamptworth Road, Lyburn Road and Black Lane involving delivery vans, groups of cyclists, visitors to the pub and because of recent and future local business developments which makes the risk of a serious accident occurring much more likely.</p>
How long has it been an issue?	Always but increasing in both danger and frequency
What would you like done to resolve this issue?	<p>Consideration should be given to imposing a reduced speed limit and better signage of the bend and the danger of pedestrians in the road.</p>

<b>Community Area:</b>	Salisbury

<b>Nature of Issue:</b>	
There's a general issue with the speed of vehicles passing through the hamlet where several houses are very close to the road and where pedestrians, including children walking to catch school transport, dog walkers and large groups of ramblers, are forced to walk on the road as there are no verges. The danger is at its worst at the hidden bend close to Yew Tree Cottage where we have frequently witnessed near accidents. The problem has always existed but the risks are steadily increasing to critical levels because of a general increase in traffic, delivery vans etc and a recent dramatic increase in traffic including heavy vehicles accessing Black Lane due to numerous business developments.	
<b>How long has it been an issue?</b>	Always but increasing in both danger and frequency
<b>What would you like done to resolve this issue?</b>	
Consideration should be given to imposing a reduced speed limit and better signage of the bend and the danger of pedestrians in the road. Any planning application for development of businesses on Black Lane, either retrospectively or for future development, should take into account the suitability of access roads and the danger posed to pedestrians.

<b>Nature of Issue:</b> (Max 600 characters)	<p>Ongoing Highways issues reported in November 2021 to the Parish Council by residents of Hamptworth. A meeting was held with the PC, Zoe Clewer WC, WC Highways and residents in November 2023. Issues highlighted:</p> <p>Advising vehicles that they are entering an area of population. Speed and volume of vehicles, houses front facing to the roadside, no pavements. Damage to verges and road due to flooding.</p>
<b>How long has it been an issue?</b>	Ongoing
<b>What would you like done to resolve this issue?</b> (Max 600 characters)	<p>Adding village entry signs to Hamptworth to advise this is a populated area. Speed – a further review of the speed on Lyburn Road with a possible reduction to 30mph due to house fronts facing directly on to the road. A review of signs and lines including bends within Hamptworth (x4) Lyburn &amp; Hamptworth Road. Include pedestrians in the road signs, there are new young families who have moved in to Lyburn Road and school children walk the road daily for the school bus. Lyburn Road &amp; Black Lane have significant areas that are now more narrow due to the overrun of vehicles and potholes at the side of the road causing walking these areas to be more dangerous, ongoing flooding is also causing verge degradation.</p>

<b>Community Area:</b>	Hamptworth village

<b>Nature of Issue:</b> (Max 600 characters)	
<p>1/ Road surface – Significant potholes and failing road edges resulting in dangerous driving conditions, vehicle damage, and associated damage to verges and hedgerows. Recent increased commercial activity in Hamptworth Estate's buildings on Black Lane have resulted in a significant increase in the size and frequency of commercial vehicles passing through the village.</p> <p>2/ Speeding – Many vehicles passing along Hamptworth Road travel in excess of 40mph. Crossing Hamptworth Rd to use the footpath to the North is often unsafe. Many vehicles travelling along Lyburn Road pass the three properties at the Hamptworth Road end at unsafe speeds. Although the speed limit is 40mph, The Highways Authority acknowledged that this stretch of road is more akin to a 30mph limit when submitting their comments in response to The Red House's planning application for a new road access and garage building.</p>	
<b>How long has it been an issue?</b>	For all of the 6 years we have lived here, but worsening in 2023.
<b>What would you like done to resolve this issue?</b> (Max 600 characters)	
<p>Surface and edging repairs to the roads.</p> <p>Signage, road markings and rumble strips for the speeding.</p>

<b>What would you like done to resolve this issue?</b> (Max 600 characters)	Entrance signs to the Hamlet of Hamptworth to indicate this area is populated. Reduction of speed, new signage to show width of road and bends in the roads of Hamptworth. Signage for vehicles to advise pedestrians walking in the road. Due to the size/volume vehicle using Lyburn Road, the road is single track in places, the verges have been damaged and there are pot holes along the edge leaving little space for passing of vehicles or pedestrians and vehicles. Signage for the ford to show depth before getting to the middle and warning sign as you enter Lyburn Road to advise likely road flooding (both ends of the road). Clearance of the ford to allow free flow of water and to prevent gardens flooding.
