Affordable Housing Working Group

How the questionnaires were handled following submission.

Digital Submissions (via the Online Questionnaire)

- Digital submissions were overseen and monitored by one member of the Affordable Housing Working Group, member with DPA training and an IT professional.
- Platform provides protection from data entries being edited, via audit trails and notification emails triggered to send to participants if detected.
- Digital submissions limited to 1x submission per IP address, built into the form and checking of IP address automated, IP address not logged on submission.
- On closing date, the online platform was closed to the public. The QR code and short link redirected to a page on the Landford Parish Council website advising of closure.

Printed Submissions

- Submissions received in an approved ballot box (used for elections) at the Landford Village Stores.
- On closing date of submissions, the ballot box was opened in the presence of 3x Affordable Housing Working Group members. Answers then compiled on a spreadsheet for future analysis.
- All printed submissions entered in to the online questionnaire, to ensure all answers recorded in the same format. These submissions were made after the public access to the form was closed and access to the form was locked down to invite only access.

After all submissions present on the online platform, the results data was downloaded to a .csv file and analysed using Microsoft Excel.

There is no personally identifiable data present at any stage of the process.





Q2. Would you support a small development of affordable housing within the Parish if there was a proven need from residents (or others who meet the criteria) with a genuine local connection?







Q5. Who owns the home you live in now?






Q6. How many people of each age live in your home?



Q7. What type of home do you live in?















Q13. If the household does not live in the Parish now, what is their connection to it? (For each box ticked please state for how long and when)





Q17. How many people of each age group would live in the new home?








